No. 945-A. - In exercise of the powers conferred by section 20 of the Ancient Monuments Preservation Act, 1904 (VII of 1904), the Governor in Council is pleased to make the following rules, viz:-

1. These rules are applicable to the areas in the Kolaba district described below, namely:-

1. "Tomb of Angre," situated in Survey No. 717, Pot No. 2, of the village of Chaul, taluka Alibag, and the space of 10 yards round about it which is comprised in the said survey No. and is bounded as follows:-

- North-Garden land of the same survey number, beyond that public road,
- South-Garden land of the same survey number,
- East-Garden land of the same survey number, beyond that Shri Rameshwar Temple,
- West-Garden land of the same survey number, beyond that Shri paddy land belonging to Anant Narayan Joshi.

2. "St. Francis Xavier's Chapel," situated in Survey No. 4, Pot No. 1, of the village of Agarkot, taluka Alibag, and the area which is included within the space of 10 yards on every side and from the corners of the said Chapel, which is situated in the said survey number and is bounded as follows:-

- North-Public road, beyond that Mahomed Sahib and Parachandra Laxman Kadam's garden land,
- South-Garden land of Mahomed Sahib and beyond that creek,
- East-Garden land of Waman Anna Wadodev,
- West-Garden land of Waman Anna Wadodev and beyond that Vishnu Narayan Vaidya's garden land.

3. "Kaman (Arch)," situated in Survey No. 601, Pot No. 1, of the village of Chaul, taluka Alibag, and the space of 10 yards from both the ends of the Kaman where they rest on the ground, which is comprised in the said survey number and is bounded as follows:-

- North-Public road and beyond that Mahomed Sahib Wadodev's garden land,
- South-Garden land of Balaji Bappa Katkar of the same S. No.
- East-Garden land of Balaji Bappa Katkar of Survey No. 600
- West-Garden land of Balaji Bappa Katkar and beyond that Pandurang Laxman Katkar's well.

2. No person shall within any of the said areas make any sort of excavation whatever, except under a license from the Collector of the district, which will generally not be granted except so far as such excavation may be deemed necessary for the repair or improvement or protection of the ancient monuments in question.

3. Any person committing a breach of the above rule shall be punishable with fine which may extend to two hundred rupees.
