No. 945-A. In exercise of the powers conferred by section 20 of the Ancient Monuments Preservation Act, 1904 (VII of 1904), the Governor in Council is pleased to make the following rules, viz:-

1. These rules are applicable to the areas in the Kolaba district described below, namely:-

✓ "Tomb of Angre," situated in Survey No. 717, Plot No. 2, of the village of Chaul, taluka Alibag, and the space of 10 yards round about it which is comprised in the said survey No. and is bounded as follows:-

North-Garden land of the same survey number, beyond that public road.

South-Garden land of the same survey number.

East-Garden land of the same survey number, beyond that Shri Naneshwar Temple.

West-Garden land of the same survey number, beyond that Kheri paddy land belonging to Anant Narayan Joshi.

2. "St. Francis Xavier's Chapel," situated in Survey No. 1, Plot No. 1, of the village of Perkot, taluka Alibag, and the area which is included within the space of 10 yards on every side end from the corners of the said Chapel, which is situated in the said survey number and is bounded as follows:-

North-Public road, beyond that Ishmael "Sheb and Panachandra Laxman Sonam's garden land.

South-Garden land of "Manan Anna" Gaudav and beyond that creek.

East-Garden land of "Manan Anna" Gaudav.

West-Garden land of "Manan Anna" Gaudav and beyond that Vishnu Narayan Vaidya's garden land.

✓ 3 "Karon (Arch)," situated in Survey No. 601, Plot No. 1, of the village of Chaul, taluka Alibag, and the space of 10 yards from both the ends of the Karon where they rest on the ground, which is comprised in the said survey number and is bounded as follows:-

North-Public road and beyond that Dastur Bhakar Gaudav's garden land.

South-Garden land of Balaji Petho Patkar of the same S. No.

East-Garden land of Balaji Petho Patkar of Survey No. 600

West-Garden land of Balaji Petho Patkar and beyond that Pandurang Laxman Patkar's w^m.

2. Excavation shall within any of the said areas make any sort of excavation whatever, except under a license from the Collector of the district, which will generally not be granted except so far as such excavation may be deemed necessary for the repair or improvement or protection of the ancient monuments in question.

3. Any person committing a breach of the above rule shall be punishable with fine which may extend to two hundred rupees.
