As required by rule 2 of the rules published with the notification of the Government of India in the late Department of Education, Health and Lands No.F.41-1/33, dated the 13th September, 1934, as amended from time to time the make the following notification in exercise of the powers conferred by section 20 of the Ancient Monuments Preservation Act, 1904 (VII of 1904), for the information of all persons likely to be affected thereby. Any person who objects to the proposed notification may forward to the Collector of Satara District a statement of the grounds of his objection within one month of the date on which the collector causes a public notice of the said notification to be exhibited on or near the area in question.
