NOTIFICATION.

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of section 3 of the Ancient Monuments Preservation Act, 1904 (VII of 1904), the Governor in Council is pleased to Confirm Government Notifications, General Department, Nos. 392-A and 392-B, dated the 13th December 1928, the latter as modified by Government Notification, Political Department, No. 6342, dated the 12th July 1929, declaring the following ancient monuments in the Sholapur District to be protected monuments within the meaning of the said Act, with the necessary change in the classification of the monuments Nos. 1 and 7 in the provisional notification No. 392A:-
