No. 4326.- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of section 3 of the Ancient Monuments Preservation Act, 1904 (VII of 1904), the Governor in Council is pleased to confirm Government Notification, General Department, No. 2687, dated the 29th March 1919, declaring the following ancient monuments in the Thana District to be protected monuments within the meaning of the said Act:-

Serial No. 1; Place where monuments are situated - Taluka Daham, town or village Khunavada; Name or description of the monuments - ~~Caves on Barad Hill~~; Class of monuments or other remarks - II (a).\*

\*To be preserved from further decay at Government expense.
